**President Report (Laura Webb)** 

Motion to approve the minutes: Dan Lintz/ Shae Hunter second.

Carlotta Sinato: Safe Routes to School.

Napa country biking coalition partnered with NCOE. National movement to get more kids out of cars when going to school. Ideally skating, biking carpooling, public transit. Safety routes to school walk audit = staff opportunity to meet with stakeholders (parents, faculty or after school programs) to identify safety barriers that prevent kids from taking alternative transit and work toward solutions. The coalition will be observing River school and add results to their audit. 90 minutes activity/ March 3rd at 2:30. Looking for parent and faculty volunteers (ideally 5) to help observe and participate. Parent square post/ Laura Webb will do.

**Laura Webb**: evolution from Charter to new campus. How do we communicate as a community the value of this program? We had a 4 hour branding workshop, led my Nancy Leavenberg. Participants were staff, faculty, board members. We are hoping to then use the workshop as a platform to continue our discussion about the mission of our school and the culture we are wanting to cultivate. This message will help attract students and families to our schools and for purposes of fundraising. Dan Lintz: value was the staff and what they brought to our workshop.

Laura Webb: encouraging parents to observe a class for purposes of understanding better and experiencing what makes River school so great. Kids are well behaved and well spoken, teachers were engaged etc. This will also help us be stewards in the community promoting River school.

Laura Webb: Teacher appreciation a few times a year. This will help teachers come

together and experience a feel for community. Would like to vote on allocating trimester funds to supplement lunch for staff once. Wednesdays are the best day for teachers can hang out. Going to carve out funds from celebrations budget \$3000 to include teacher appreciation (no more than \$1000).

**Principal Report:** 

New student orientation. Kept it short and didn't want to ask for money. Introduction. A card with the 4 R's (voice, community and sense of self) Drumming performance. A great night. New families were very receptive.

<u>Project night</u> is on March 10th 6-8pm. Want to combine this night with ribbon cutting. Food trucks from 5-6. Classroom element 6-7. Ribbon cutting from 7-8.

Edible School Yard: Great experience. Interesting to see how they have organized. Every day they cycle through the garden through science. Then they have cooking through social studies. Integrating into the classroom. Discussions about food pricing. What stood out is the communal table. Additionally, they have a pergola fit with benches and they do affirmations etc.

<u>Track and Field</u> not complete. Adding sod/finished by April. Working on drainage.

<u>Cafeteria Kids</u> LOVE their new space. It is seamless.

<u>District</u> is going through financial stuff. We are ok. Our enrollment is up.

Meeting with Linda Inlay regarding school culture. She has brought some ideas up. Question would be: do we want to invest in using a measuring tool. Customizable. Is the Family Foundation interested? \$3000.00.
